


Next Generation Internet

- The trick is to do extreme centralization on hardware, infrastructure, spectrum and security and extreme decentralization on services at the same time.



R&I Action:

- Call for & selection of top-teams

Sub-grantee:

- One legal entity with one specific project
- Young researchers from outstanding academics, hi-tech startups and SMEs
- Carry out the R&I work
- 50.000 200.000 Euro, 9 12 month






How to get Funding...


- About 80% of EU funding is granted through programmes managed in the EU countries themselves. Where the European Commission directly manages funding, it does so by awarding grants, launching tendering procedures, etc. ...
- The European Commission helps fund projects and organisations which contribute to the implementation of EU programmes and policies. It grants funding through calls for proposals and projects.
- To get funding for your project, you will need to identify a relevant call for proposals/projects and carefully follow the specific guidelines on how to apply – each call is unique. Your project will compete for funding with projects submitted by other applicants for that call.









