We are contacting you to share some interesting updates from U4IoT, your friendly neighbourhood support action! In this newsletter edition, we would like to present to you our upcoming activities at the IoT Week 2019 in Aarhus!

Sessions

You are cordially invited to our session entitled '[Exchanging Large Scale Pilot End-User Engagement Experiences](#)' Part I & II scheduled on Wednesday June 19 from 9.45 AM to 12.30 PM in the [ARoS Museum](#) (ARoS Sky Room). During this two-part session, you will be provided with the opportunity to exchange your end-user engagement experiences and share best practices with other IoT Week participants. Simultaneously, it will be an opportunity for U4IoT partners to inventory how the U4IoT tools and support services are used and gather feedback for future CSA practises.

Sustainability scenarios for Large Scale Pilots

U4IoT is working on supporting the Large Scale Pilots (LSPs) in attaining sustainability of their value creation through the development of sustainability scenarios. This workshop will explore the individual needs of the LSPs in order to create sustainable value creation after the projects end. The workshop will explore different aspects of value creation within the project and assess how this value can continue

beyond the life of the project. U4IoT will collaborate with Create-IoT, who will analyse common needs across the LSPs in creating sustainable value creation.

Joint workshop with Create-IoT, Trust in Invisible Agents

In collaboration with Create-IoT, U4IoT will participate in a session which is focused on trust in invisible agents. This participatory roundtable session will be held on Tuesday June 18 from 11:30 AM to 14:15 (including lunch break) in [Musikhuset Aarhus](#), Room 224. The session provides an opportunity to engage with expert practitioners from various domains in a wide ranging discussion around transparency issues in the IoT. In so doing, U4IoT will present IoT adoption barriers and recommendations for LSPs and other IoT experts on how these barriers should be tackled. This kind of cross-discipline approach can lead the LSPs to a deeper understanding of complex, domain-wide issues, and provide a roadmap to feed back learnings into product and system design.

Demos

Once a day, from Tuesday until Thursday, U4IoT will also demonstrate end-user engagement practices at the public expo in the Ridehuset building. Engagement of citizens in Large Scale Pilot (LSP) projects is evident to e.g. research, create and evaluate, thoughtful Internet of Things (IoT) solutions. During each demo one of the U4IoT tools and support services will be showcased. LSP projects and the general public will be asked to participate in the demos by making use of the Crowdsourcing Tool, Privacy Game, Co-Creation Workshop Toolkit and End-User Engagement Toolkit.
